CODE OF CONDUCT

The TRC Code of Conduct applies equally to all members. Membership of this Club requires an acknowledgement that members are bound by the Code of Conduct, and will conduct themselves in accordance with its precepts. A breach of the Code of Conduct may result in the imposition of disciplinary measures.

- 1) All members of TRC are entitled to an opinion, and have the right to a 'fair go'. We respect the rights of others to hold opinions that may differ from our own, and will not treat people unfairly or with discourtesy or malice by reason of their holding opinions that are contrary to our own.
- 2) All members of TRC are entitled to expect that they will be treated fairly, irrespective of their race, ethnicity, religion, gender, or sexual identity.
- 3) Bullying, in any of its guises, will not be tolerated.
- 4) We acknowledge that all members have a right to feel safe at TRC. Stalking, predation, intimidation, assault, threats, or unwelcome sexual attention are behaviours that will not be tolerated.
- 5) We agree to consume alcohol responsibly when in the Club environs or when representing TRC elsewhere.
- 6) We respect the private property rights of others. Members will not use equipment owned by other Club members without first seeking and obtaining the express permission of the owner.
- 7) We value the notion of taking responsibility for our own actions. In the event that we cause damage to (or loss of) property that is owned by others, we acknowledge that we have an obligation to "make good" to the owner.
- 8) We will treat TRC boats and equipment with great care and will use it gratefully, acknowledging that it is also used by others. We will not engage in reckless behaviour that puts TRC equipment (or the safety of ourselves and others) at any sensibly avoidable risk.
- 9) We value good sportsmanship. We play by the rules and will not condone those that do not observe the rules of fair competition.
